The Workshop on Requirements Engineering 2021 is now in its twentieth-fourth edition. This series of workshops on the area started in 1998 as a meeting of the Ibero-American requirements engineering community. However, since then, it has attracted attention from researchers and practitioners from other parts of the world. The WER format promotes discussion and knowledge exchange between the academy and industry members. As in the last editions, this one will also feature invited lectures from well-known researchers and practitioners, and tutorials. This edition will introduce a track for tool presentations related to the state-of-the-practice in Requirements Engineering and a session for doctoral and master's thesis presentations.

WER 2021 invites submission of proposals for 3-hour tutorials in the field of Requirements Engineering as part of the Tutorial Track (WER-TT). The tutorial presenter can choose to carry out the presentation virtually or in person. In the latter case, the local organization committee will evaluate that possibility near the event based on pandemic conditions at that time.

#### TUTORIAL TRACK SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Tutorial proposals should not exceed two pages, must be written in Portuguese, Spanish or English, according to the [LNCS page format](#). The proposals will be evaluated and selected by the Program Committee.

Tutorial proposals should contain the following information:

- Title;
- Abstract (between 150 and 250 words);
- Objective (2-3 sentences);
- Outline of main topics;
- Target audience;
- Name, affiliation, and e-mail of presenters;

- Presenters' bios (2-4 sentences for each presenter);
- Language of tutorial presentation (Portuguese, Spanish, or English); and
- Tutorial presentation mode (on-line or in-situ).
